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

- Data from the Swedish adult cp-registry (CPUP), reported 2012 to 2019
- The latest PT/OT assessment of all adults born between 1943 to 2003





The Swedish Adult CPUP

Assessments

- GMFCS III-V – every year
- GMFCS II – every second year
- GMFCS I – every third year




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- 1888 adults ranging from 16-78 years
- Median age 25 years
- 54,6 % were males
- 76% had spastic CP






Age groups



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



Independent living levels were almost equal in adults at GMFCS levels I and V


Personal assistance was the single most important factor for independent living

Assistance >160 h/w (OR 57.07, 95% CI 32.35–101)




